School Highlights

Let us highlight your school's theatre program! School Highlights will include 1-5 Instagram story pages highlighting your uploaded show/rehearsal content. *Schools can submit posters for multiple shows but will only have 1 School Highlight scheduled. Most highlights will be posted at 10:00 AM or 6:00 PM, and added to a monthly “Highlight” on our page.*

- Story Post 1 – Includes your School Name with either your show poster or your show title and dates.
- Story Post 2-5 – Compilation posts including a fun mix of photos and videos submitted
 - The number of posts will be adjusted depending on the content submitted.

What to submit:

Photos – at least 10 preferred, no more than 25 | Videos – No more than 6, no more than 1 minute per video

Ideas for what photos to include:

- ✓ Production Photos – full cast on stage or specific scenes
- ✓ Candid photos backstage
- ✓ Special design elements, Costumes, Set, etc.
- ✓ Any special props, stunts or magic
- ✓ Techies!
- ✓ Cast rituals/warm-ups/community building

Ideas for videos to create:

- ✓ Shake My Hand In Character
- ✓ Get Ready with Me
- ✓ Guess the Character
- ✓ Guess the Choreo
- ✓ Lip Sync – Guess Who’s Singing
- ✓ Your show choreo teasers
- ✓ Performance clips from the wings
- ✓ Tech content
- ✓ Miscellaneous current trend

How to submit content for School Highlights:

- Gather content from rehearsals or opening night performances. All content must be submitted by 11:59 PM on your opening night. Late submissions will not be accepted or used in the School Highlight.
- Label files “IG – [SCHOOL NAME] – [Content information or number]”

- Highlights will be posted between 1-5 days after your opening day submissions. A calendar of School Highlight scheduled dates will be provided to participating schools.
