DIGITAL PERFORMANCE

Former director Dr. Paul T. Kwami and his students pay tribute to the original nine members of the Fisk Jubilee Singers®, who were organized as a choral ensemble in 1871. As today's singers explore the stories of the trailblazers who paved the way, they reflect on their roles as students and preservers of the choral group's rich legacy. Inviting viewers to learn the significance of the Negro Spirituals and their value in today's culture, the film honors the 150th Anniversary of the Fisk Jubilee Singers®.

Created in collaboration with Dr. Kwami and director Jon Royal, the film is produced by Tennessee Performing Arts Center (TPAC).

Created by circus performers Seth Bloom and Christina Gelsone in collaboration with kinetic sculptor Daniel Wurtzel, Air Play was devised through years of experimentation with simple materials, movement, and technology.

Lulu confronts big change, having just moved in with her Gran. To make things a little more comfortable, Gran gives her a velveteen rabbit – just like the one her mom had. Velveteen and Lulu form a special bond, making some of the other toys jealous and leaving Velveteen wishing he could live outside with the "real" rabbits he meets through the window. Ultimately, Velveteen discovers the transformative power of loving relationships and what it means to be real.
